

William Soney Collection Notes and Inventory

William Soney, a descendant of Chief Little Turtle, visited the Wolcott House Museum in 1967. His visit was described by Randolph C. Downes in the *Northwest Ohio Quarterly*, volume 39, #3, Summer 1967 on page 4.

In 1972, Mr. Soney wrote numerous letters to Mr. and Mrs. Edward Lamb about the Pottawatomie and Miami Indians, Little Turtle and Frances Slocum, Little Turtle's mother, who had been stolen from her parents at the age of five. Some of the information in his letters is repeated numerous times. One letter mentioned his plans to visit on June 15, 1972 at the age of 96.
