Theodore Waite of Toledo died in 1870 at the age of 48 (b. 1822). He was married to Sarah Wandell; according to the 1900 census Sarah had had 9 children. Not all of the children have been identified at this time. Charles W. was born ca. 1853, died March 20, 1894; Henry DeHart was born ca. 1855, died November 1908; Sarah Lenora was born June 13, 1859, died May 22, 1953; George was born ca. 1862 and Albert was born ca. 1866.

Charles married Margaret Maloney; they had 5 daughters: May M., born October 11, 1881, died December 28, 1969; Eleanor, born November 1, 1884, died July 4, 1915; Helen (Nellie) A., born , April 26, 1886, died January 14, 1983; Margaret A., born May 3, 1888, died January 20, 1973; and Sarah, born December 23, 1889, died January 11, 1983. Charles and his siblings appear to be 1st cousins once removed to Morrison R. Waite, Chief Justice of the United States; Charles' daughters would have been 1st cousins twice removed to M. R. Waite.
